What are the facts?

- 600 Mio. people in sub-Saharan Africa have no access to electricity
- 80% of them live in rural areas
- many African countries have a rapidly growing population, that needs perspectives and jobs
- Renewable energy especially solar has become cost effective and competitive
- Renewable energies are an important tool to overcome poverty

our targets are:

- to develop decentralized energy structures in rural areas
- to create new jobs and productive use with the energy
- to expand training in the energy sector
- to replace fossil fuels such as diesel, kerosene or petroleum with renewable energy

- to start projects like mini grids or energy efficiency in eight countries
- to build on partnerships between German and African partners
